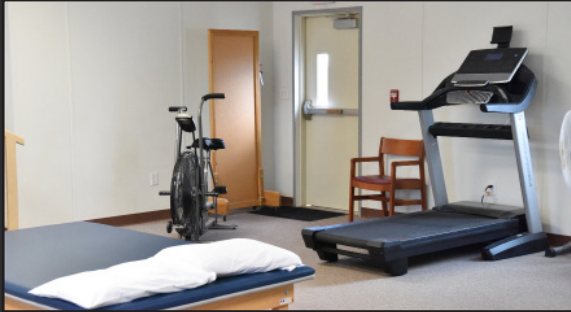


Our therapy features a hands-on approach that offers each patient the attention they deserve. The equipment used to aid in rehabilitation and therapy are pictured below.

What is physical therapy?

How do I know I need physical therapy?

You may benefit from physical therapy if you have had a recent setback due to illness, injury, surgery or other physical impairment. You then need to see your primary care provider to determine whether you would benefit from physical therapy. Once that is determined, your doctor will give you a written prescription for therapy and you are ready to call our department to set up your appointment for your initial evaluation to start therapy.

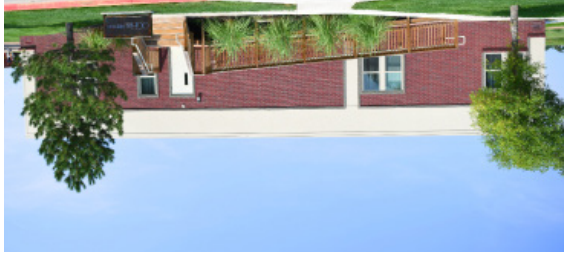

What about Speech Therapy?

Speech Therapy at Ochsleer General Hospital offers inpatient, swing bed, outpatient, and home health services. For adults, speech therapy at OGH can address swallowing disorders, motor speech disorders, language disorders, and voice disorders. For the pediatric population, speech therapy at OGH can address expressive and receptive language disorders, speech sound disorders, fluency disorders, social communication disorders, motor speech disorders, and use of augmentative and alternative communication.

Where is the Ochsleer General Hospital Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation building?

The Ochsleer General Hospital Physical Therapy building, located on the North East Corner of the OGH Main Hospital is 2,000 square feet of space designed by Physical Therapy staff members to provide quality physical therapy services.
