

ogan received her Bachelor's of Science degree in Communication Disorders from West Texas A&M University in 2017. She received several honors and was very active while at WTAMU including Communication Disorders Outstanding Junior Student Award, President of the National Student Speech-Language Hearing Association (NSSLHA), National Society of Leadership and Success, and Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society. Logan was also the recipient of several scholarships.

In 2019, she graduated from Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center with her Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology. She earned several awards and honors including, Commendation on comprehensive exams and the Lubbock Monterey AMBUCS Chapter Scholarship. Logan was a member of the National Student Speech-Language Hearing Association (NSSLHA).

ogan's professional experience as a Speech-Language Pathologist began in Amarillo, Texas at the Legacy Rehabilitation and Living Center and Care Option for Kids. From administering standard speech and language assessments, bedside swallow evaluations to cognitive screenings to determine patients' eligibility for therapeutic services and improve quality of life, safety, and participation within activities of daily living. She then moved on to Therapy2000/Green Apple Therapy in Amarillo, where she gained experience in comprehensive speech and language evaluations to devise treatment plans addressing pre-linguistic skills, functional communication, and improved participation in the home environment. Logan performed swallow studies/evaluations, training to patients and family members in use of compensatory strategies to increase safety with PO intake, and much more while at BSA Health System, Rebound Rehab, and Northwest Texas Hospital System.

ogan said recently, "I am very excited and honored to be providing speech therapy services at OGH and the surrounding communities. I look forward to providing a valuable service to this area. I'm thankful for this opportunity that has been provided to me by OGH and plan to serve the community with quality patient care."
