Once every 12 months Medicare provides what is known as an Annual Wellness Visit which is free to all Medicare beneficiaries who have Part B. We here at Ochiltree General have been talking about this a lot over the past few years – postcards, newsletter articles, radio spots, and so on – because we want you to be able to take full advantage of the benefits you have earned.

Annual Wellness Visits are designed to help prevent disease and disability based on your

current health and risk factors. Your provider will ask you to fill out a questionnaire - called a Health Risk Assessment - as part of this visit. Answering these questions can help you and your provider develop a personalized prevention plan to help you stay healthy! It can also include: a review of your medical and family history; developing or updating a list of current providers and prescriptions; personalized health advice; and an opportunity to discuss advance care planning.

Please, for the sake of your loved ones, take advantage of this opportunity.

# WILLIS FOUNDATION



Dean Allen Willis

The Dean Allen Willis Foundation was created to support education and training for Ochiltree General Hospital medical personnel in the fields of trauma and emergency

care. These courses help the hospital to maintain its Level IV Trauma center accreditation.

The foundation assists with tuition and travel-related expenses, such as mileage, hotels and meals. Some of the training takes place at OGH. This allows more of the medical team to take advantage of the learning experience without having to leave Perryton.

Many of these courses are required every two years for our health professionals to refresh their skills. A nursing representative from OGH attends the Regional Advisory Council on Trauma and the Texas Trauma Coordinator Forum to stay up-to-date on the latest techniques and equipment.

Nurses are certified in advanced cardiac life support, emergency nurse pediatric course, pediatric advanced life support, fetal heart monitoring, neonatal resuscitation, cardio pulmonary resuscitation and trauma nurse core curriculum.

Doctors take courses in advanced cardiac life support, pediatric advanced life support, advanced trauma life support and advanced life support in obstetrics.

The Dean Willis Foundation also offers a nursing scholarship. The scholarship seeks those willing to work at OGH in exchange for tuition and related expenses. The goal is to hire additional registered nurses for the hospital.

Dean Willis died in 1996 from injuries sustained in an auto accident. His family desired to honor his life by helping Ochiltree General Hospital.

The Dean Allen Willis Foundation qualifies as a 501 (c)3 tax-exempt organization and encourages donations. The mailing address is P.O. Box 1046, Perryton, TX 79070. Tax-deductible contributions will help benefit health and emergency care for Perryton and the surrounding area. 🌾
